Relay For Life is a 24 carnival style team event that raises awareness of cancer in the community, and raises much needed funds to fight cancer in Taranaki. Teams of family, friends, neighbours and work colleagues commit to raising \$100 each and keeping at least one member on the track for the entire 24 hoursbecause cancer never sleeps. The first lap of any Relay is dedicated to survivors. We honour survivors for their courage, strength and victory over cancer as they lead the way in the first lap of the event, proudly wearing special sashes. Following this at 1pm we will be holding a special lunch for survivors.
